<u>Port Road Races</u> Logan Park 22 September 2007

Some excellent Caversham results were achieved at the Port Chalmers Road Races held on September 22nd in cool windy conditions.

Lyndon Brown was 1st runner home in the Boys U 19 4.5k in a time of 16 minutes, while Daniel Balchin 4th and Tony Payne 5th assured Caversham of the teams title. Tony took fastest time honours by 1 second from Lyndon recording 15.59. Tony also received the Denver Trophy for the men 19 and under aggregate on the Otago Road Championships and the Port Road races. These results are further confirmation of a great winter season for Caversham Junior Runners.

Marion Maxwell provided the highlight for Caversham in the 12k Senior Port Chalmers to Dunedin race. Running off a handicap of 23min 45sec. Marion was first in the Open Women with a time of 50min 7 seconds and was also first among the competing Masters Women. This performance comes two weeks after Marion placed first in the Masters Section of the Moro Half Marathon bettering her best time by 2 minutes with 1.26.52. Kerry Rowley who finished 7th in 55moin 18sec, and Claire Giles in her first Port Road race 9th in 57min 8secs were the other contributors to Caversham finishing 2nd in the teams race with 17pts. Caversham took second place in the Nickells Challenge Cup awarded to the club achieving the best team aggregate for the men's 10k handicap road race and the Port Chalmers to Dunedin Road Race with 62 points. This placing confirms a consistent series of results achieved by Club Members over the latter part of the winter season. During the after race awards for the Port Road Races a presentation was made to Caversham Life Member Pat Sidon for his outstanding record in the

Edmund Cup Steeplechase which was run for the

100th time ion September 1. Pat first competed in

the Edmund Cup as a Junior in 1949 and won the race 11 times between 1954 and 1967.


