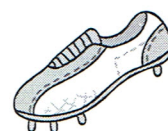

## Barnes CrossCountry Report

A horrible day weather-wise with a biting cold southerly wind made for tough racing at the above event held at Kettle Park on May 27th. While a number of Caversham competitors performed creditably their opportunities were limited by handi-capping that could fairly be described as tough in many cases.

In the Senior men's 5k race Daniel Balchin was first Caversham competitor in 13th place with a time of 18.54. Others who recorded good times were Tony Payne 18.17, Lyndon Brown 18.32, Clinton Coker 19.40, Ian McDonald 20.53 and John Landreth 21.36. The latter two staged a great battle throughout the race each passing the other at various stages. It was nice to see Caversham number 585 featuring prominently in Mondays O.D.T. The Senior Women performed really well to achieve 2nd in the teams section to Hill City. Karen Rowley 5th in 18.54, Christine Montgomery 7th in 17.43 and Marion Maxwell 9th in 16.00 were the main contributors while Maria Sleeman 18th in 17.40 and Olivia Robb 23rd in 17.22. Sally Van Rooyan also did well in the conditions in her first Barnes race. Olivia was one competitor who received no favours from the Handicapper, however her time was third fastest among the Women 19 competitors.

Ben Anderson 9.43, Royce Madigan 10.09 and Robert Brown 9.22 finished 10th, 11th and 12th in the Boys 16 and under race all times they would be happy with in the prevailing conditions. Caversham also achieved 2nd place in the Boys 12 and under section with Bradley Horne our best competitor finishing 3rd in 5.58.

## Lovelock Relays 2007 Report Results

Caversham was represented by 12 teams at the annual Lovelock Relays held in perfect conditions at the University Oval on May 5th. All club teams ran well and achieved some encouraging results to build on for events held later in the season. It was great to have five Caversham teams competing in the Children's U.12 races with two recording third placings.

The Senior Men's team of Tony Payne, Daniel Balchin, Lyndon Brown, Will Buchanan, Clinton Coker and Robert Brown finished a creditable 7th in the A Grade event in an overall time of . Tony was fastest team runner with 4.20 while Daniel and Lyndon also ran really well with respective times of 4.25 and 4.23. Being the youngest team in the A Grade their effort was encouraging for other races over the next few months.

The Masters Women No1 team of Joanna Tokona, Christine Montgomery, Maria Sleeman and Marion Maxwell waged a great battle with Arika for race honours eventually finishing 2nd in only 2 seconds away from 1st place. This was an excellent team effort and augurs well for an even better result next time out hopefully at the Leith Club Cross-country Relays. The Masters No2 team were notable for producing almost identical times Sally Van Rooyen and Gail Sharp recording the same time of

6.57 and Julie McMahon and Paula Anstey recording 6.42 and 6.44 respectively. Sally enjoyed her first Lovelock Relay becoming aware of the support given to all Caversham team members. The Senior Women's team of Kerry Rowley, Karen Rowley, Suzanne Sharp and Olivia Robb finished 2nd in the B Grade event with an overall time of . Kerry recorded fastest time of followed by Olivia with 5.56.

The two Caversham teams in the Mixed Social Grade both competed well with a number of close finishes between the various teams. The teams of Steve Murphy, Maurice Burrows, Ian McDonald and Colin Tocher finished 2nd in , while the team of Tony McIntyre, Malcolm Giles, Glen Sutton and Hamish Sutherland were 3rd in . Excellent times were recorded by first time Lovelock Relay competitors Hamish Sutherland 5.06, Steve Murphy 5.01 and Colin Tocher 4.43. The results achieved by these two teams would be satisfying for Malcolm Giles who has played an important organizing role in putting the teams together.
